A Wilderness Canoeing Experience in Algonquin Park For Grade 8 Graduates

Outreach is an introductory outdoor camping/canoeing course featuring a 9-day canoe trip in Algonquin Park. No previous experience is necessary to enrol in our Outreach program.



Students will spend 7 days (“Barn Days”), training and learning new skills at Gould Lake (days only), before heading out on a 9-day wilderness trip in Algonquin Park. These skills include: canoeing, portaging, map reading, introduction to leadership, low-impact camping techniques, and cooking canoe trip meals. It also gives them the challenge of learning how to work cooperatively with their peers. Bus transportation is provided to and from Gould Lake each day, as well as to and from Algonquin Park. All food and equipment (i.e. canoes, paddles, tents, and packs) is provided for the canoe trip in Algonquin Park. Students are required to bring their own PFD (lifejacket), sleeping bag and personal gear. Students are required to bring their lunches and drinking water for the 7 days spent at Gould Lake.
