

ISU - Independent Study Unit

WHAT IS THE INDEPENDENT STUDY UNIT?

During Outdoor Skills, most of our learning will be done experientially – that is, we will learn by doing and reflecting on what we've done. The independent component of this course allows you to take what you've learned about wilderness camping and apply it to designing your own camp. Using the skills, knowledge, and ideas you've gained through your previous tripping experience, it's now time to make your own summer camp dreams become a reality...on paper at least.

This assignment requires you to create one of the following: **a brochure, a poster, or a flyer** to outline your camp and its programs.

THINGS YOU NEED TO HAVE INCLUDED IN YOUR ISU:

- **Camp Name.**
- **Camp Location and description of the camp facilities.**
- **Programs** the camp offers and **costs** for those programs.
- **How are these programs accessible and available to everyone in the local area?** (ie. Disabilities, limited budgets, and any other limitations that might hinder a person from being able to attend your camp).
- **How does this support lifelong participation in healthy active living activities such as the programs you run at your camp?** (ie. Social interactions, social and cultural needs, and any other thing that would promote someone to continue with these programs in the future).
- **Make sure to use pictures/photos!**

IMPORTANT DETAILS:

- **Ensure your name is on your work as it will be hard to give a mark to nobody.**
- **Independent:** The work required to complete this assignment will be done by you, outside of the hours when you are with your OS group. It is recommended that you complete as much of this assignment as possible before your OS session begins – once we start, our schedule is very busy and does not leave much time to work on your ISU.
- **Help:** For help before your OS session begins, please contact the OS Program Supervisor, Haley Segee (segeeha@limestone.on.ca). For help during your session, just ask one of your instructors.
